The Krka National Park is open to visitors throughout the entire year, and it can be visited by boat, by car, or on foot.

TOURIST FEATURES

- The presentation of traditional crafts at Skradinski Buk and Roški Slap.
- Viewing the remains of the former hydroelectric plant "Krka", the first in eastern Europe, at Skradinski Buk.
- Walking along the wooden bridges and educational trails at Skradinski Buk and Roški Slap.

Boat excursions:

- 1 To the Franciscan monastery on the island of Visovac – a 2 hour trip (half an hour at Visovac),
- 2 To Roški Slap – a 3 hour and 30 minute trip, including a half hour visit at Visovac,
- 3 To the Krka Monastery and the fortresses of Trošenj and Nečven – a 2 hour and 30 minute trip.

In addition to these excursions, specific guided tours are also available, which must be arranged in advance. To reach Skradinski Buk, visitors can rent a boat at Skradin, and will be accompanied by a park water ranger. The Krka NP also has several restaurants and buffets for refreshment.

The entrances to Skradinski Buk are: Lozovac and Skradin.

LOZOVAC ENTRANCE

This is the main road entrance to the Krka National Park for tourist buses and individual visitors. Throughout the entire year free parking is available for individual visitors and groups (tourist buses). Individual visitors are transported to Skradinski Buk and back from April to October by buses of the National Park, while in winter entrance is possible by car. Buses of tourist agencies drive their own groups. Access to Skradinski Buk is also available along a 800 m path, and the walk takes 10 minutes.

SKRADIN ENTRANCE

The transportation of visitors by the boats of the Krka National Park is organized according to a timetable. From April to November, organized groups must reserve a boat in advance.

It is also possible to travel from the Skradin bridge to Skradinski Buk along a 3 km bicycle path, or on the boats of tourist agencies (note: the previous announcement of such boats to the park administration is required). The Information Center of the Krka National Park in Skradin contains a reception desk, a souvenir shop, and a multimedia gallery. Entrance tickets and boat excursion tickets can be purchased by visitors at all the above entrances (or reception centers) of the Krka National Park.
