

## ROŠKI SLAP



Roški Slap is located around 36 km downstream from the source of the Krka River. It was named for the fortress of Rog, which was located on the right bank of the Krka, southeast of the village of Rupe. The beginning of the barriers consists of a series of small cascades (the locals call them the Necklaces), followed by numerous branches, backwaters, and islands. The canyon in this section widens like a funnel, and the greatest width of the barriers measures 450 m, in length around 650 m, while the total difference in height is 25.5 m. The main waterfall is located at the end of the barrier, where the Krka falls from a 15 m height into Visovac Lake. Travertine forms at the Roški Slap falls include caves, tufts, thresholds, barriers, and also cones. The cones at the foot of the main

waterfall represent a unique feature of Roški Slap. A road crosses the travertine cascades and has connected both banks from as far back as the Roman period. Nature is quite untouched throughout most of the Roški Slap area, making it particularly attractive to true lovers of pristine nature. Along the left bank of the cascades are a series of attractive small mills, some of them still in

The complex of mills at Roški Slap is among the most interesting and valuable ethnographic landmarks in Dalmatia and Croatia. The mills can be seen from April to October.

Roški Slap can be visited by road from Drniš, Knin, and Skradin, or with the organized excusion boats



of the Krka National Park from Skradinski Buk, where the tour lasts 3 hours and 30 minutes, and includes a half hour visit to the island of Visovac. The tourist features of Roški Slap from April to October include visiting the water mills, ancient wash stations, and hand looms, various catering facilities, walking a pedestrian path along the "Necklace" cascades, and organized transportation by boat to the Krka Monastery and the fortresses of Trošenj and Nečven, in a tour that lasts 2 hours and 30 minutes. Entrance tickets to the Krka National park and boat excursion tickets to the Krka Monastery can be purchased by visitors at the entrance (reception) to the Krka National Park -
